MYPBGAMES FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

1. What PCVG activities are INCLUDED in the \$20 club membership fee?

These PCVG activities are included in your membership:

- Leagues
- Drill & Play
- PCVG 4.0 Weekly Competitive Tournament (WCT)
- Pickleball Warriors
- PCVG Rating Clinics
- DUPR Camps
- Tournaments (The tournament features within MyPBGames will be implemented in the future.)

2. What PCVG activities are EXCLUDED in the \$20 club membership fee?

The PCVG activities listed below will continue to be free of charge.

- The Instructional Program activities will not be included in the club membership, and they will
 continue to be free of charge as these are entry level activities that are owned by The Villages
 Recreation & Parks Department. The Instructional Program includes:
 - Beginner Mentored Play
 - Introduction to Pickleball Part 1
 - Introduction to Pickleball Part 2
 - Non-Volley Zone
 - Full Court Concepts
 - Partner Development Concepts
 - Strategy Play Concepts
- PCVG Referee Training will not be included in the club membership and will continue to be free of charge.

Why do we need to charge players a club membership? I thought we had sponsors who donate funds to the PCVG.

Sponsors vary from year to year. There is no guarantee that we will continue to have sponsor support. We need to provide a method for ensuring PCVG costs are covered.

4. How does the membership work?

The MyPBGames' membership is a "rolling" membership. This means that your one-year membership is based on the date that you started your membership within MyPBGames. If you started your membership on September 1st, 2025, then your expiration date is August 31st,

2026. This means that renewal fees are due on the anniversary of your join date, so you get a full year regardless of when you join.

5. How will I pay for my membership?

All payments will be handled online. When you become a member through MyPBGames, you will be asked to make your \$20 payment online via a credit or debit card. Accepted cards are American Express, Discover & Diners Club, Mastercard, and Visa.

6. What costs does the PCVG incur?

The PCVG incurs the following costs: State & Federal filings, website software, web domain name fee, Mailchimp (our scale email service), SignUp Genius, MyPBGames, office supplies to support our activities, league and tournament medals, supplies for Rating Clinics and DUPR Camps, shirts for instructional volunteers, appreciation dinner for Drill & Play instructors.

7. Who monitors the PCVG's budget?

The PCVG has a Board of Directors with 11 voting members. The Board has a Treasurer who oversees and manages incoming funds and outgoing expenses. The PCVG's focus is on covering the expenses it takes to manage and execute its activities. It is not focused on making a profit as we are non-profit organization.

8. With the implementation of MyPBGames, will all leagues now report scores to DUPR?

No. Each league will continue to record or not record DUPR scores as they are currently doing which is what is deemed best for the league. Each league's webpage states whether DUPR scores will be recorded into the DUPR system.
